working at the Women's Growth Center and at Jewish Family Services, she opened a private practice where she saw clients, primarily women, for 32 years. Her dissertation about the role of mothers in incest families, "Maternal Protectiveness Following the Disclosure of Intrafamilial Child Sexual Abuse" was published in The Journal of Interpersonal Violence. Her first

foray into writing began with a chapter, "Double Bind: Healing the Split" in *Women Changing Therapy*, published in 1983. The book described individual's personal experiences with mental health issues and problems in living she thought would be useful to students in social work, psychology, and counseling. Her current book, *Feminist Therapist: How Second Wave Feminism Changed Psychotherapy and Me* recounts the seminal contributions of feminism on women's psychology,
